PRESENTATION OF THE SEMINAR

Intellectual property, particularly patents, plays a major role in innovation and discovery in biotechnology. This broad area of biology involves living systems and organisms that develop or make products, or any technological application that uses biological systems, living organisms, or derivatives thereof, to make or modify products or processes for specific uses. Policy and adoptions issues in biotechnology and biomedicine have important consequences in the tech sectors as a back-drop for pending legislation and recent court rulings. How policy is adopted, implemented, and interpreted have profound impacts on food production, medical ethics, ecology, etc.

Inter alia, statutory obstacles to patentability, what is patentable or not in different countries, and moral issues, have already eroded the effective life of the patents of many pharmaceutical industries, raising some questions that will be addressed during this Seminar.
